NBRC 2022 State Economic & Infrastructure Development Grant is Now Open

Northern Borders Regional Commission (NBRC) is accepting applications for 2022 State Economic and Infrastructure Development grants. NBRC now requires a Letter of Interest (LOI) as a first step of the application process. LOI's are due on April 22. Eligible organizations include non-profits and government entities (local, state, and Indian tribes).

Regional Project Prioritization List

The 12 Regional Development Corporations of Vermont identify projects of priority and importance in the region using input from Regional Planning Commissions, municipalities, partners, and communities. GBIC is the Regional Development Corporation for Chittenden County.

Projects identified in the Regional Project Prioritization lists may support business retention and expansion, create programs that encourage job creation and workforce development, expand access to high-speed broadband, and implement new or innovative economic development practices. Projects on the Regional Project Prioritization lists are eligible for additional scoring points when applying for Northern Border Regional Commission Economic & Infrastructure Development funding.

New Remote Worker Grant Open

ACCD has a grant program for people who move to Vermont on or after February 1, 2022, and are working remotely for an out of state employer. The grant will reimburse relocation expenses for qualifying workers, up to \$5,000 or \$7,500 (depending on location).

State Trade Expansion Program Opportunity

The State Trade Expansion Program (STEP), funded in part through a grant with the US Small Business Administration (SBA), offers financial awards to help offset the cost of select export related expenses. Historically, different types of expenses could be reimbursed at different rates. Effective immediately, these caps on individual activities are eliminated. Qualified companies may now apply for up to 4 activities per year for a total award of up to \$20,000.
